Your Agency Name promotes a professional company image to our community, clients and their families. Your Agency Name’s caregivers must follow the below standards in their work appearance.

1. Caregivers will wear a Your Agency Name ID badge when providing care to clients, volunteering and industry events.
2. Caregivers are required to wear clean, neat and appropriate size uniforms at all times. Approved uniform colors includes: Purple,yellow,blue and green. Appropriate undergarments must be worn at ALL times.
3. Work shoes must be comfortable and non-slip. Foot-ware must be closed toed for workers comp and personal safety **No flip-flops or thong sandals.**
4. When attending a doctor or professional appointment with a client, the employee will be provided with the client’s preferred dress code and must adhere to it. Ie. Khaki pants, polo shirt.
5. Registered nurses should be professional dressed and or follow above guidelines.
6. Caregivers are expected to keep their groomed and clean. Long hair must be managed to prevent interference with caring for the client. Male caregivers must neatly groom and style facial hair.
7. Caregivers must limit the use of perfumes and fragrance. They may be offensive to clients and or family members.
8. Caregivers must limit the use of Jewelry during client care to prevent skin tears, bacteria transmission etc. This does not include wedding rings (unless large stone) and or watch.
9. Caregivers must managed and groom fingernails by keeping them trimmed, clean with client safety in mind. Caregivers should refrain from wearing “fake” nails.
